

We celebrated 'National Mathematics Day' by hosting various events, including a Maths Quiz, games, and an exhibition. Students had the




chance to view videos highlighting the accomplishments of the acclaimed mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan, adding educational and inspirational elements to the day.
