

Day' along with Tree plantation activity. At the end of the programme, all pledged to keep the earth green as much as possible.






# ENGLISH LANGUAGE DAY & WORLD BOOK DAY

May 06, 2023


"Laughter is the best medicine and today on World Laughter Day, let's all take a big dose of it!"

safeguarding and conserving nature.












# FATHER'S DAY
