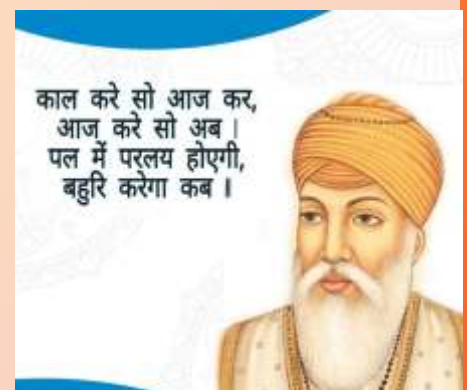
Martyrdom Day of Guru Arjan Dev

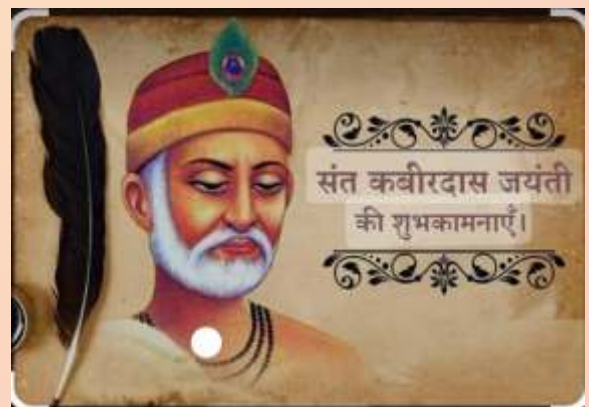


Sant Kabir Das Jayanti
