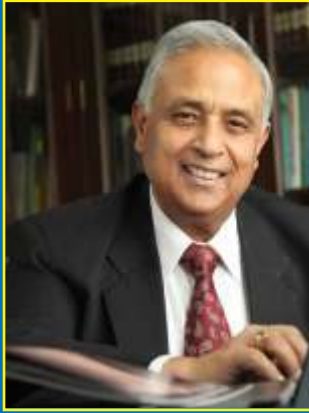

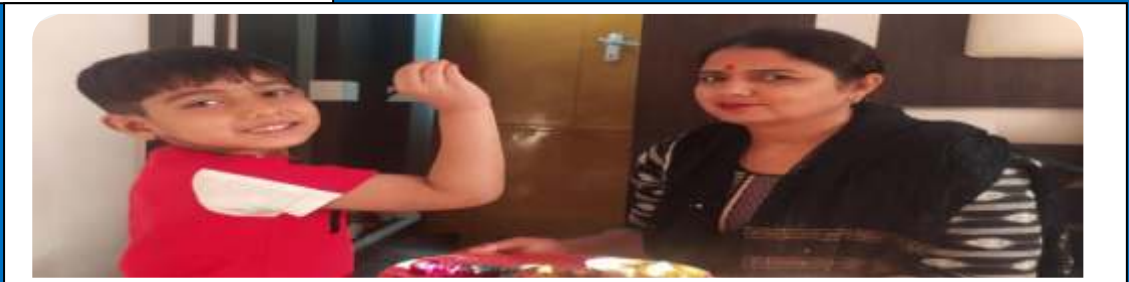


MOTHER'S DAY
